Linc Housing is one of Scotland's leading providers of new and improved homes and support services. The housing association aims to build 3,200 homes over 5 years, with over two-thirds of these for social and mid-market rent.

Amongst 13 current developments onsite, Granton Harbour is just one example of Linc Housing's development programme to deliver added value and benefits to the community.

Funded by Link, the Scottish Government and the City of Edinburgh Council, the flats will be available for affordable rent in May 2020.

EWI installers MP Group UK appointed SPSenvirowall to supply its RendaClad system comprising of 12mm RendaClad Lite firerated boards and utilising a highperforming white silicone primer and render topcoat (WH77) to the SFS construction.

The £400,000+ façade package benefits from a seamless rendered rain screen system and ensures that the wall structure has a fully ventilated and drained cavity.
